

Landowner's Consent to Enter Property

The Law in Texas:

It is against the law to hunt or fish on privately owned lands or waters without the permission of the owner or owner's agent. No person may pursue a wounded wildlife resource across a property line without the consent of landowner of the property where the wildlife resource has fled. Under the trespass provisions of the Penal Code, a person on a property without the permission of the landowner is subject to arrest.

One copy of this form shall be filed with the Verde West Ranch Property Owners Association. One copy shall be carried by the party (s) that has permission to hunt on said property.

Trespassers shall be lawfully escorted off the private property by any member of the VWRPOA Board of Directors. Refusal to vacate the property by the trespasser shall lead to enforcement by Val Verde County Sheriff or TPW.

VWRPOA roads are private roads for the purpose of access and egress by owners to private property and not intended for joyriding, sightseeing, or four wheeling. Doing so could be construed as trespassing.
